## **Waverley Night NA invites players to trial for selection in the 2021 Waverley Rep Teams.**

*All players that were selected in the 2020 program have been offered a position to be in the 2021 Program even if changing age groups, either in a team or as a training partner but must still register and trial. The number of teams selected will depend on the number of players trialing.*

### **Coaches:**

**Waverley Night Netball Association Inc. are excited to be working with Norma Plummer AM as part of the program in 2021.**

Norma played, captained and coached the Australian Diamonds, also held coaching positions with the Australian 21/U team, AIS, Melbourne Pumas and Melbourne Phoenix. Norma has worked at the elite level for 30 plus years and recently finished a position as Head Coach of the South Africa National team after the recent World Netball Cup.

Norma will run regular sessions with the players and mentor the coaches in the program.

The Coaches will be a part of a team that will also include a strength and conditioning coach.

### **Selections:**

Independent selectors will work with appointed coaches to carry out selection of the teams.

### **Eligibility:**

Players must have played in a team/club in the Waverley Night Netball Association competitions in 2020 **and / or** will play a minimum of 7 games in 2021, in a Waverley Night Netball Association competition.

### **Commitment:**

Each player will be expected to pay a levy to be a part of the program. The levy will cover the cost of competition and tournament entry fees and umpire fees, coach remuneration, court hire for training and other specialist programs.

### **17 & Under Program:**

The selected team will play in the Waverley Night NA Wednesday 17 & Under Premier League Competition at the Waverley Netball Centre & Ashwood Courts and play 2 tournaments in preparation for the Netball Victoria Association Championships.

Players will be expected to pay a levy (amount to be confirmed of approximately \$720).

### **13/U & 15/U Program:**

The selected teams will play in the Waverley Night NA Thursday night Competition at the Waverley Netball Centre & Ashwood Courts and play tournaments including the Netball Victoria Association Championships.

Players will be expected to pay a levy (amount to be confirmed of approximately \$820).

### **11 & Under Program:**

The selected teams will play in a variety of tournaments and receive Specialist Development Coaching.

Players will be expected to pay a levy (amount to be confirmed of approximately \$470).

### **Training:**

#### **Outdoor Court Project / 2021 Autumn Season**

The Outdoor Court Redevelopment will start at the end of 2020 / start of 2021.

For this reason, whilst the outdoor courts are unavailable at the Waverley Netball Centre we will be using Waverley District NA – Ashwood courts for training.

Training will be held predominantly on a Tuesday night from 5.30pm to 7.30pm.

Waverley Night Netball Association are making a commitment to provide a player and coach development program as part of the Representative Team program.

### **Uniform:**

All players selected will be expected to purchase a uniform. Training t-shirt, hoodie, socks and back pack.

Dress: A levy is charged for the dress, the dress remains the property of Waverley Night Netball association. The dress can be exchanged for a larger size at anytime. It is only charged once for each player over a journey in the rep program.

### **When you register:**

- # Providing an opportunity for players to be part of the Netball Victoria Player Pathway at Association Representative Team level.
- # Provide accredited coaches for all teams.
- # To give players the opportunity to develop as an athlete and person.
- # Provide player feedback from coaches to assist in development.
- # To provide a nurturing, positive, inclusive environment.

Players/ Parents commit to:

- # Playing in a team/club, for a minimum of 7 games, in a 2021 Waverley Night Netball Association competition.
- # Encouraging your daughter/son at every opportunity.
- # Abide by the Netball Victoria Codes of Conduct (available through our website)
- # Agree to pay the Player Levy set, by the due date.
- # Attend all training sessions, competition games and tournaments unless in exceptional circumstances.
- # Be respectful to all players, coaches, umpires and officials.
